Multimedia Guest Access Faceplate

HDMI Port :

- Allows screen casting from laptops or devices to the in-room smart TV
- HDMI 2.0 ensures support for 4K video and multi-channel audio.
- Connected to TV using in-wall HDMI cables or extenders (HDBaseT if required).

USB Port :

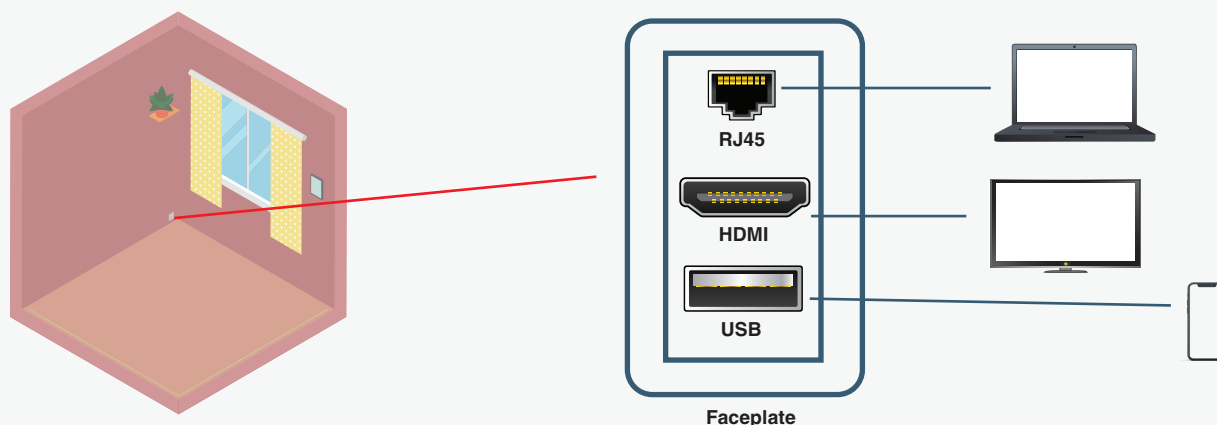
- Offers USB-A or USB-C ports for device charging (phones, tablets).
- May support USB data connectivity with a room control system.
- Safe voltage output (5V), with overload protection.

RJ45 Ethernet Port :

- Enables high-speed wired internet access.
- Supports Gigabit/10GbE data rates using Cat6/Cat6A.
- Ideal for business guests and streaming-heavy users.

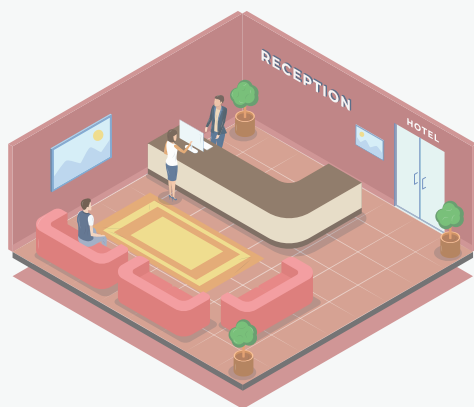
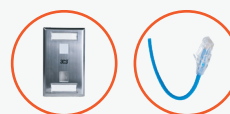
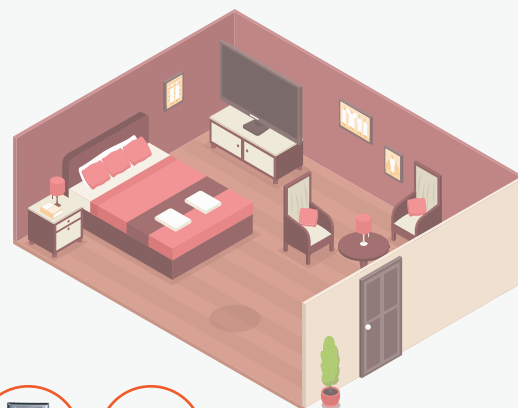


Smart In-Room Solutions

Self-Service Check-In/Check-Out Kiosks

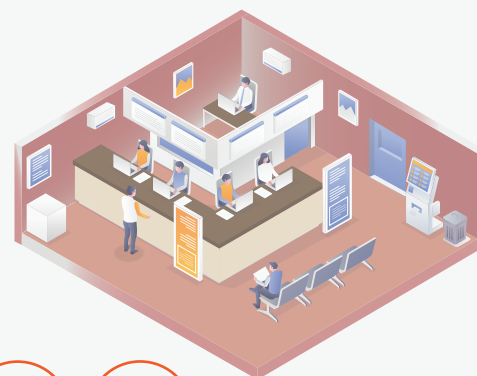
Empowering Contactless Hospitality with Reliable Passive Infrastructure

Embedded USB ports enable integration with peripheral devices like fingerprint scanners and receipt printers. Patch cords connect these devices within the kiosk enclosure and to wall or floor mounted outlets. Copper or fiber backbone ensures uninterrupted connectivity, especially during high traffic. This infrastructure ensures 24/7 uptime and scalability—supporting efficient lobby operations.

Fiber optic backbone (singlemode or multimode) is used for long-range outdoor zones. Armored and LSZH cables ensure durability and fire safety. Cabling routes terminate at NVRs and control rooms using modular panels, enabling real-time analytics and event response.



Guest Services & Billing Integration

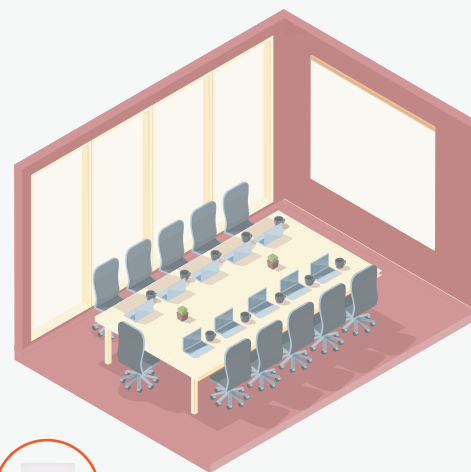
